

# Skyline Spring Pair Pace Rules



## Entries:

2 riders to a team, \$45 per horse.

NO DAY-OF ENTRIES. [Online entry](#) must be completed by midnight, April 6<sup>th</sup> in order for us to assign ride times. Riders are encouraged to pay online via credit card or paypal, but cash/check option will be available at registration.

Pace Division Selection - The division you enter is determined by the SPEED, not the HEIGHT. There are three divisions:

- Division A ( 400m per minute, galloping pace, fences intro-training available, select prelim fences.)
- Division B (350m per minute, cantering pace, fences intro-novice available)
- Division C (250m per minute, Trotting pace, fences intro-novice available/optional)

Times will be posted Friday April 7 at noon.

Inquiries/requests should be made by 6pm that day.

Online entry also includes opportunity for show jumping schooling rounds in outdoor arena (weather permitting) and overnight/day stabling.

Cross country schooling and season passes will be available for purchase on site. (Riders MUST have wristband to school – those schooling without will be fined.)

## Skyline Eventing Park Information

Skyline Address: 995 West 1000 South, Mt Pleasant, UT 84647

From US 89 in Mt Pleasant, turn right onto 500 W, make the first left onto 1000 S. The Sanpitch Event Center and Contoy Arena are on the left. merchandise will be available for purchase!

All dogs must be leashed- \$100 fine for loose dogs, payable to the cross country course fund

## Pair Pace Explanation/Rules:

1. Two pairs of horses and riders will complete a designated course at a designated pace. Pairs must stay together while on course.
2. Horses may jump in tandem (side by side) or nose to tail.
3. Pairs do not need to jump the same height.
4. Competitors must jump fences in numerical order with red flags on right and white flags on left. C Division riders who opt not to jump a fence must still pass through flags.
5. No penalties for falls, refusals or runouts – just get to the finish flags! (Stewards will be on hand and will help assess if a horse or rider fall deems then unable to complete.)
6. Time for each team begins when the first horse's nose crosses the start line, and ends when the last horse's nose crosses the finish line.
7. Teams will enter course in 2 minute intervals. Please yield to faster teams in the case of being overtaken on course.
8. No timing or measuring equipment allowed on course or on course walk.
9. Team closest to optimum time (- or +) will be named the winner.
10. Pairs must ride at posted times or risk forfeiture.
11. Attire/Tack: All riders MUST have approved ASTM/SEI helmet, boot with heel, and protective vest. Additional vests will be available at start box for those who cannot provide their own. Pinneys/numbers must be visible at all times. Horse must be in safe and clean saddle/bridle.
12. Please try to restrict your time in the warmup area to 20 minutes prior to your run. Lunging areas will be available.
13. The course will include the water complex!
14. The course will also be much longer than the standard cross country course at all levels – prepare to cover some ground!
